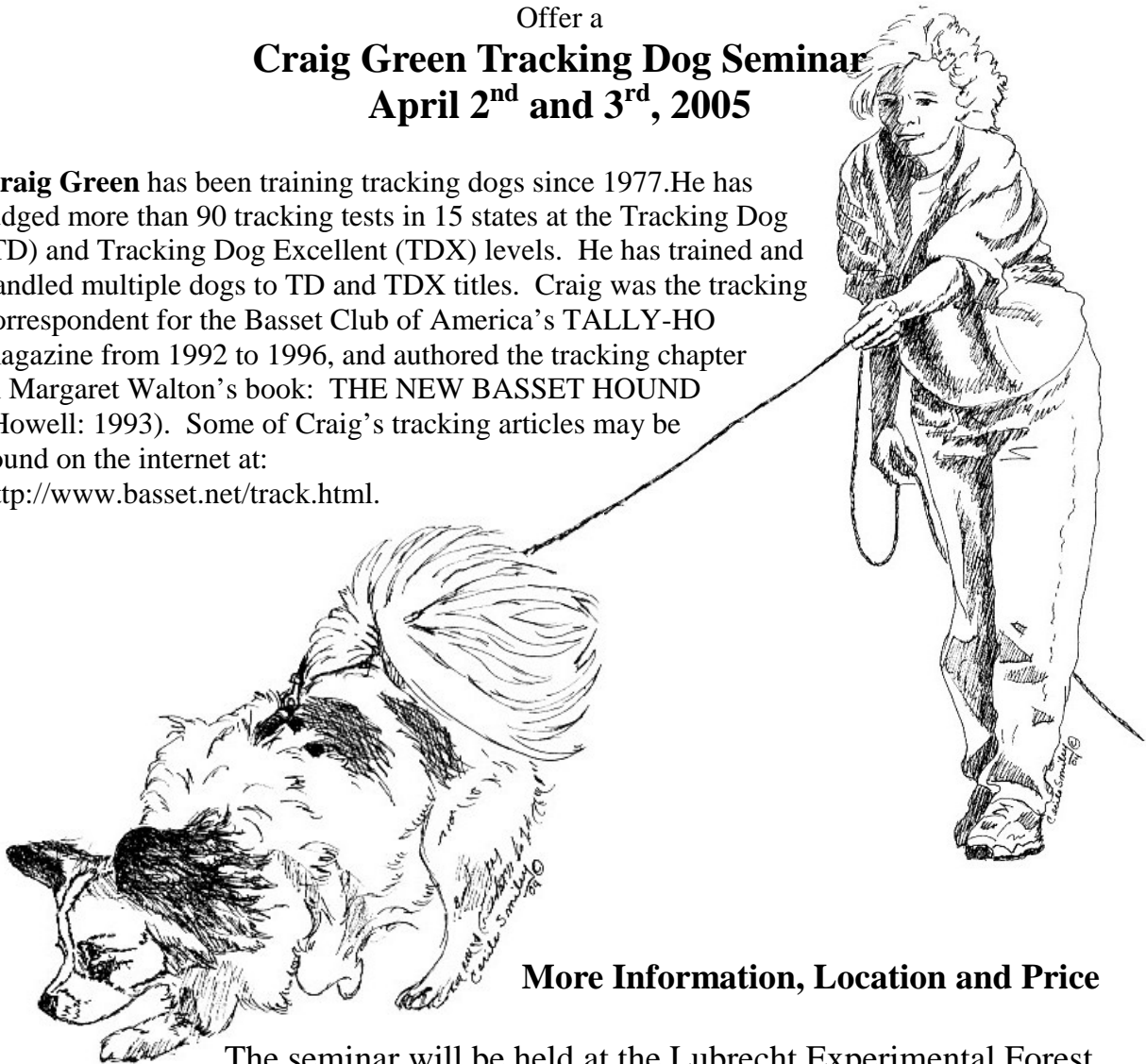

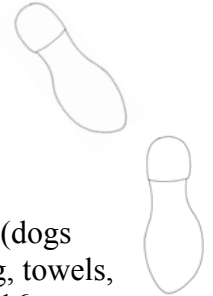
**More Information, Location and Price**

The seminar will be held at the Lubrecht Experimental Forest, 30 miles NE of Missoula. This seminar is limited to 10 dog/handler teams (\$150.00) and unlimited auditors (\$50) and will be geared for beginners. Lubrecht Experimental Forest offers sleeping cabins that hold from two to six people (dogs welcome) and rent from \$30 to \$45/night/cabin. People must bring their own bedding, towels, etc. and the bathrooms are in a separate building. Their lodge (dogs unwelcome) has 16 rooms with two single beds per room and they rent for \$55.00/night double occupancy and \$35/night for single.
