Workshop Details

- This workshop is limited to 15 working spots (in total) and 15 audit spots (in total). We are offering 1 day, but this is limited to only 5 working and/or audit spots each day. These 5 (1day spots) will be deducted from the 15 working and/or audit spots each day. This workshop will only accommodate 15 dogs/handlers (each day) in total.
- Cost is \$300 for a working spot – 2 days
 - Cost is \$160 for one day of working spot (limited 5 working spots each day)
- Cost is \$140 for an auditor spot – 2 days
 - Cost is \$80 for one day of audit (limited 5 working spots each day)
- Payment can be made by cheque/money order made out to “Papillon Canada 2019 Specialty,” or by e-transfer to marg.zacher@gmail.com (The passcode for the transfer will be : **PAPILLON2019** (all caps))
- You will be notified when your registration form and payment have been received.
- A \$25 cancellation fee will be charged for cancellations up to March 26th, 2018. No refunds will be issued after March 27th, 2018 (except for in the event that the working dog is either sick or deceased, vet certificate required)
- In April, we will email all registration information regarding the event.
- We will also be offering private ½ hr sessions with Lee on Friday April 27 – starting at 5pm (on a first pay, registration basis). Cost will be \$40 (30min) or \$75 (1 hr)
- Lunch is included with registration (Subway box lunch only) Each meal comes with a tasty sub, choice of side and a freshly baked cookie all conveniently packed in a handy to-go box.

Scooter and Lee - 2017 #1 Obedience

I have competed for over forty years in the obedience ring, and have over five hundred High in Trials, and 8 OTCH dogs and 4 GMOTCH dogs

My last six dogs have all achieved 200 scores. Since 1986, I have been in the top ten dogs In Canada 27 times

with my last 6 dogs. My first Miniature poodle “Smurff” was the first poodle, any variety to obtain a GMOTCH title.

I teach competition obedience and have over 40 students now. Over the years, my students have achieved OTCH titles on a variety of breeds and now several have their MOTCH and GMOTCH titles. I have also put a RAE rally title on one of my dogs and a WC hunting title, on one of my miniature poodles. He is the only Can. Am Ch.Ca. GMOTCH Am OTCH Miniature poodle in Canada to obtain this title. Retire now with 87 HITs. My last dog achieved his CD CDX & UD in less than a year with perfect scores and multiple high in trials from all three classes and obtained his GMOTCH in less than three months.

I now compete in the US and have two Am. OTCH dogs with multi High in Trials and multi High Combined. Plus 3 other Am UD dogs. EZ and Scooter have their American OTCH . Scooter was the #1 dog in Canada for 2017 and #2 dog in Canada for 2015 and #3 dog in 2016 with multiple HIT and the second highest average 197.71 of any dog in Canada with only six months of trials. He was invited to the US Westminster obedience trials for 2017 and 2018.

My number one goal is to have happy working dogs that enjoy the obedience ring and being part of our family.

1) What is the difference between a Working or Audit Spot?

Working: means you are a Dog / Handler team, will handle your dog at the Seminar and receive instruction from Lee either in a group or individually. Benching is limited, only bring, dog and crate.

Audit (NO DOGS in building): means you will participate as a member of the audience only.

2) When can I register for the Workshop?

Registration for the Lee Kozicki Workshop will open on Mon Jan 2nd, 2018 and close Monday March 26th, 2018. All filled out registrations and payment in full must be received by the closing date.

3) How do I make sure to get a Working spot?

Since registration is "Limited" to 12 working spots, if your interest is to participate in a limited working please register as early as possible. All limited registration spots will be filled **on a first come first serve basis and a \$50 non refundable deposit is required within 5 business days to hold a Working spot.** If the Working and/or Audit limit fills before the closing date a waiting list will be kept and no deposit is required to be on the waiting list.

5) How do I submit payment for my registration? There are Two payment methods available.

1. Cheque/Money Order - Once you have completed the registration form, send it to the payee ("Papillon Canada 2019 Specialty"- this is whom to write the cheque to) & mailing address 8824-51 Ave, Edmonton AB T6E 5E8 (ATTN; Margaret Zacher) Either include the registration with cheque or scan and email that directly to marg.zacher@gmail.com. Until we get the cheque/money order no spot is secured

2. Email Transfer - Once you have completed the registration form, scan and email that directly to marg.zacher@gmail.com. You will also need to do an e-transfer with your bank for the amount. Until we get the e-transfer no spot is secured. The passcode for the transfer will be : **PAPILLON2019** (all caps)

6) What is the refund and cancellation policy?

There will be NO refunds for ANY registrations after the closing date March 27th, 2018.

If a dog cannot participate in a working spot due to illness or death, a refund may be requested in writing and must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate prior to April 7, 2018. The participant can still attend the workshop, as an audit spot, with the difference refunded back to the participant.

If the Seminar is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, all registration payments including deposits will be refunded in full.
